## Accreditation Process By: George Hatter

Charter House recently had a visit from Audrey Lavine from Fountain House in New York city and Joe Shaffer from Independence Center in St. Louis Missouri. These two faculty staff were visiting from Clubhouse International for an Accreditation visit to see how well Charter House adheres to Clubhouse International Standards.

We get these visits every three years. Depending on how well we are adhering to the Standards, we will either not be accredited, get a three-year conditional accreditation where we will need to work on some recommendations from the visiting faculty staff in order to become fully accredited, or we will be fully accredited.

In past accreditation visits, we were given three-year conditional accreditation. Each time we were given one year to work on the recommendations. After we working on the recommendations, we submitted a report on all the work that we did and were then given full accreditation.

Audrey and Joe said that they felt very welcomed here and were very impressed with the side by side work that is done at Charter House. They had some suggestions and ideas on things we can work on. Audrey and Joe gave us 5 recommendations on standards that we were not as strong at as we can be. They said that they will fill out their official report and talk with Clubhouse International to give us an official

determination. We should get that determination sometime in late February or early March. We look forward to seeing what is on the official report and working on the recommendations that they give us. We know that this will only make us a stronger clubhouse.

## Denise's Sweet Treats!

#### Strawberry Crisp

For the Strawberries:

- 5 cups strawberries (sliced)
- 1/4 cup granulated sugar
- 3 tablespoon cornstarch

For the Oat Topping:

- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 3/4 Cup old fashioned oats
- 2/3 cup brown sugar
- 1/4 cup granulated sugar
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 cup (melted) butter

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees Ferenheight
- 2. In large bowl mix together strawberries, sugar and cornstarch until combined, then set aside.
- In another medium bowl mix together the flour, oats, brown sugar, granulated sugar, salt and butter. Mix until coarse crumbs form.
- 4. Grease a 9x10 cast iron skillet with shortening.
- 5. Put the strawberries in the bottom of the prepared skillet and then top with the oat crumbs, making sure it is spread evenly over the top.
- Bake for about 45 minutes (up to 60 minutes) or until the edges are bubbly and the oat topping is lightly browned.
- 7. Remove from oven and serve with a scoop of vanilla ice cream if desired! ENJDY!
